

Credential Document Review (CDR) Letter - Request

Purpose

Registration with CMLPSK (SSMLT) occurs following your arrival in Canada. Persons applying for the Saskatchewan Immigrant Nominee Program (SINP) may require a CDR letter as evidence they currently meet the initial requirements for registration for NOC: 32120

Step 1: If you have applied or will be applying for the SINP, you **must** have completed an approved Prior Learning assessment (PLA) and have been deemed eligible to write the Canadian MLT entry to Practice examination(s) or already have successfully written the examination(s).

Approved PLA Process:

Effective November 1, 2025, all new PLA applicants must complete the PLA process with Canadian Alliance of Medical Laboratory Professionals Regulators (CAMLPR).
