## Purpose

New Applicant – Not Labour Mobility or New Graduate requesting a Practicing Licence are defined as persons who successfully challenged the approved MLT entry to practice examination(s); and

- Have successfully completed an approved Prior Learning Assessment (PLA) and have not worked as a MLT in another Canadian jurisdiction; or
- Worked as a MLT in a non-regulated Canadian jurisdiction.

NOTE: CMLPSK may request additional documents or documents directly from source.
