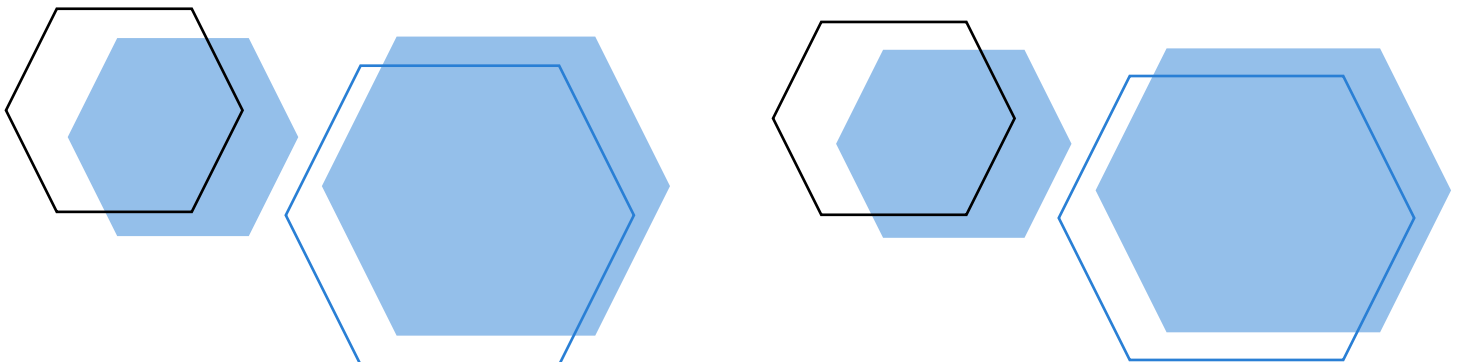

MEMORIAL EDUCATION FUND

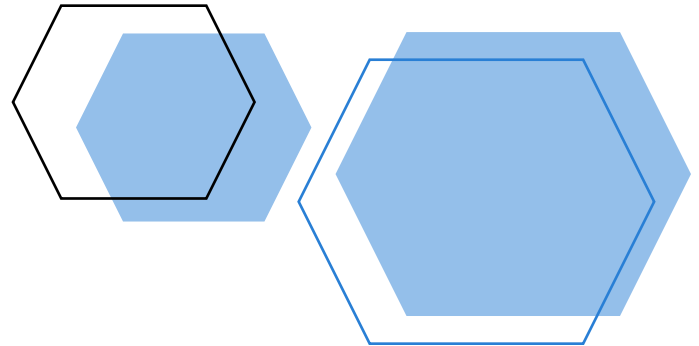
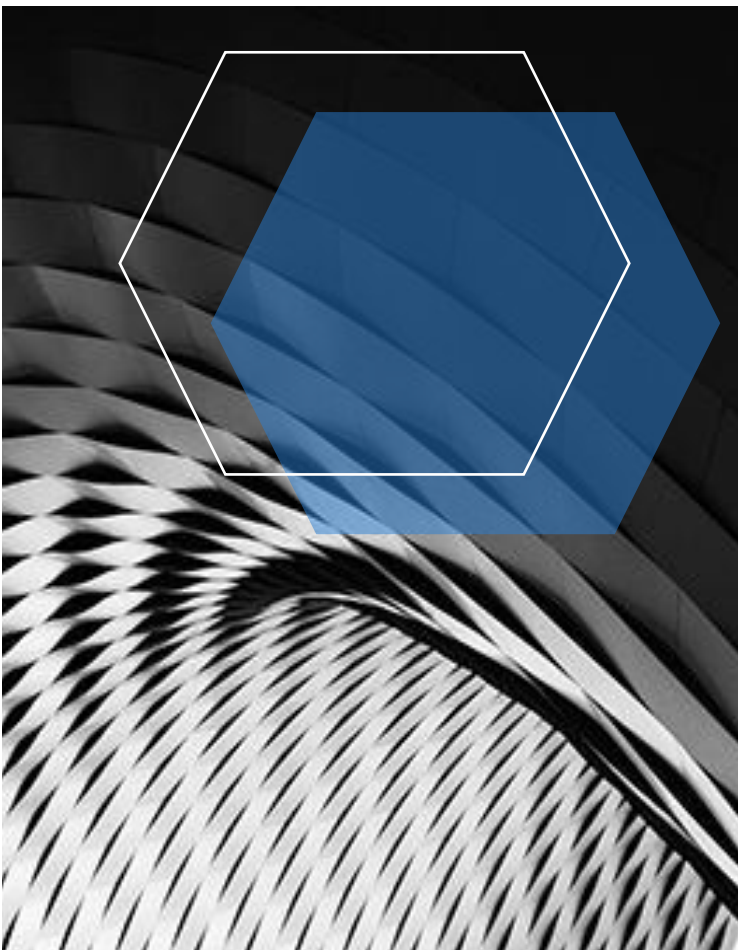
Application deadline: March 31- extended

STRENGTHEN PUBLIC PROTECTION

Review of Quality Assurance Program

The Professional Practices Committee has reviewed best practices used by regulatory authorities and compared them to the College's current quality assurance requirements, including Continuing Professional Education (CPE) and practice hour requirements. As a result of this review, the Committee will submit recommendations to Council for consideration at the May 28 council meeting for potential revisions to the quality assurance program.

Revising bylaws, policies and processes

The CMLPSK office is currently drafting revisions to the MLT Act and bylaws for consultation with the Ministry of Health. Following the consulting, if the ministry approves that CMLPSK can proceed, feedback will be requested from registrants, other regulatory bodies, employers and the public.

The CMLPSK office has drafted several policies to be submitted to council for approval at the May council meeting. If approved, they will be communicated to all registrants.
