

Credential Document Review (CDR) Letter - Request

Purpose

A Credential Document Review (CDR) Letter is intended for those applying to the Saskatchewan Immigrant Nominee Program (SINP) and requires evidence that they currently meet the initial requirements for registration with the College of Medical Laboratory Professionals of Saskatchewan (CMLPSK).

Please note: A CDR Letter is **not** a licence to practice as a Medical Laboratory Technologist (MLT) in Saskatchewan and **does not** constitute registration with CMLPSK.

Step 1 – Complete the Required Assessment

Before applying for a CDR Letter, applicants must:

- Successfully complete the Canadian Alliance of Medical Laboratory Professional Regulators (CAMLPR) Prior Learning Assessment (PLA). Information about the PLA process, visit www.camlpr.org ; and
- Be deemed eligible to write the Canadian MLT Entry-to-Practice Examination or have already successfully completed the examination.

NOTE: Individuals who previously completed the CSMLS Prior Learning Assessment (PLA) process should contact CMLPSK at contactus@cmlpsk.ca to determine options available.

Step 2 – Apply for a CDR Letter

Once Step 1 has been successfully completed, applicants may:

- Submit a CDR Letter application (link to online application); and
- Provide the required supporting documentation listed below.
