

Practising Licence – New Graduate

Purpose

New Graduate applicants for a practising Licence are defined as persons who:

- have graduated from a Canadian accredited MLT education program within the previous 2 years, and
- have not worked as a MLT in another Canadian jurisdiction, and
- have successfully challenged the approved MLT entry to practice examination(s).

NOTE: CMLPSK may request additional documents or documents directly from the source.

Evidence of MLT Education	Canadian Accredited MLT/S program -Degree/Diploma or official transcripts
Entry to practice exam	Evidence of success on MLT entry to practice exam(s)
Continuing Competence Requirements	Exempt for 5 years from Graduation Date.
Professional Liability Insurance	Minimum \$2million professional liability insurance. See the Professional Liability Insurance Policy
Jurisprudence quiz	Applicants will receive the jurisprudence manual and quiz after they have completed and paid for the application.
